Mr. Randy Edwards, age 74, passed away Monday, March 9, 2020 at Atrium Health Main in Charlotte.

The memorial service will be at 3 p.m. Sunday, March 15, 2020, at Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary located at 14542 Choate Circle, Charlotte, N.C. 28273, with the Rev. Bruce Jones officiating. The family will receive friends following the service.

Randy Edwards was the son of the late Peggy and Dawson Edwards of Rutherfordton, North Carolina. Randy spent most of his life in Charlotte where he was a Flight Engineer/Instructor on the C-130s Cargo Planes and also a Civil Service Employee for the Air National Guard.
